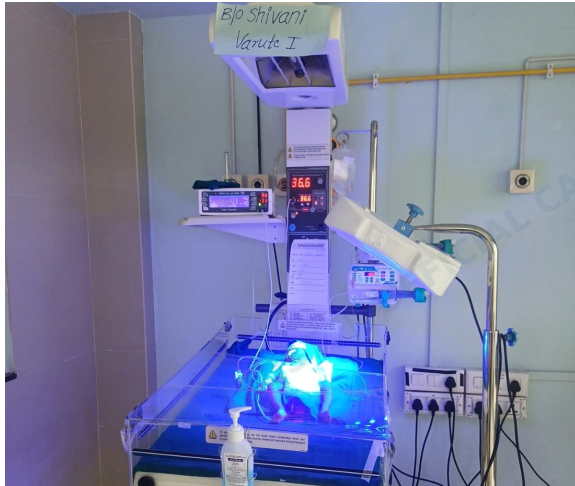


BORN TOO SOON. FIGHTING FOR EVERY BREATH.

Two tiny premature babies are lying in incubators in Kolhapur - too small and too early to continue without hospital care. Their parents cannot meet the cost alone.

This is a real family facing an impossible medical bill. These twins are the couple's first children. Born at only 32 weeks, both are fighting complications of prematurity. Their father works as a labourer, and the family's documented annual income is just ₹41,000.

A FAMILY WAITING BESIDE TWO INCUBATORS

Shivani and Ashitosh Varute welcomed their first children - twin babies - far earlier than expected. What should have been the happiest moment of their lives became a medical emergency. Instead of taking their newborns home, the parents are waiting beside two incubators at Sai Sparsh Children's Hospital while both babies receive NICU care.

The babies' father earns through labour work. A Government of Maharashtra Priority Household document records the family's total annual income as ₹41,000. The treatment estimates are many times beyond what the family can arrange.

TWO INCUBATORS. TWO FIRST-BORN BABIES. ONE FAMILY WITH NO WAY TO MEET THE COST ALONE.

WHY GOVERNMENT SUPPORT IS NOT AVAILABLE

Both hospital certificates state that the treating hospital is not empanelled under the MJPJAY scheme; therefore, the babies are not receiving benefit under that scheme.

WHAT THE DOCUMENTS CONFIRM

Premature birth	Both babies were born at approximately 32 weeks.
Intensive care	Both require continued NICU monitoring and treatment.
Family income	₹41,000 per year, recorded in the government Priority Household document.
Scheme position	No MJPJAY benefit at the treating hospital, as stated on both estimates.
Hospital	Sai Sparsh Children's Hospital, Kolhapur, Maharashtra.
Admission	Both babies admitted on 11 August 2026.

The family has supplied hospital estimates, laboratory reports, identity and income-supporting documents for verification. Government IDs and full residential details are intentionally excluded from this public appeal.
